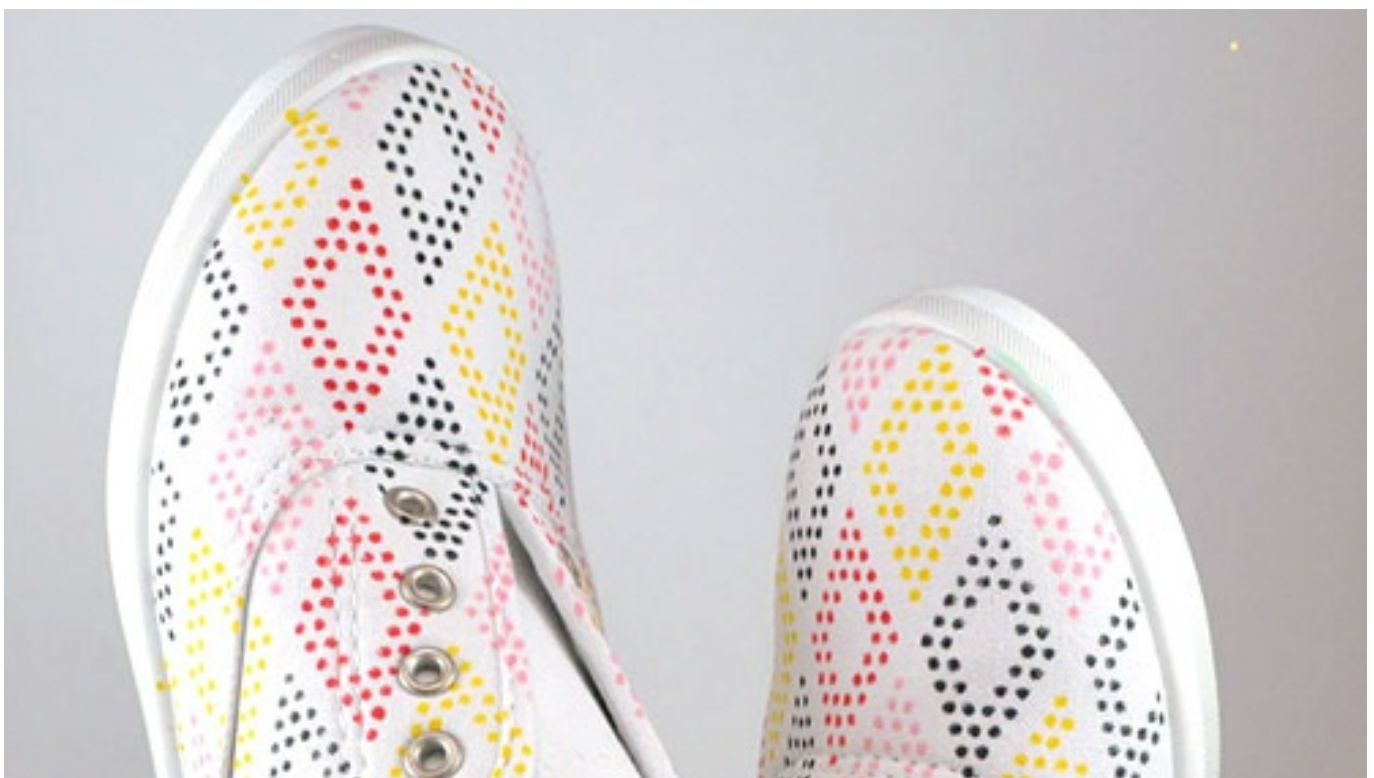




DIY Dot Patterned Sneakers

My first effort was comical and looked circus ready. My second I ditched the color for all black and then realized that though neat looking, weren't what I was going for. Just like Goldilocks, the third try was just right!

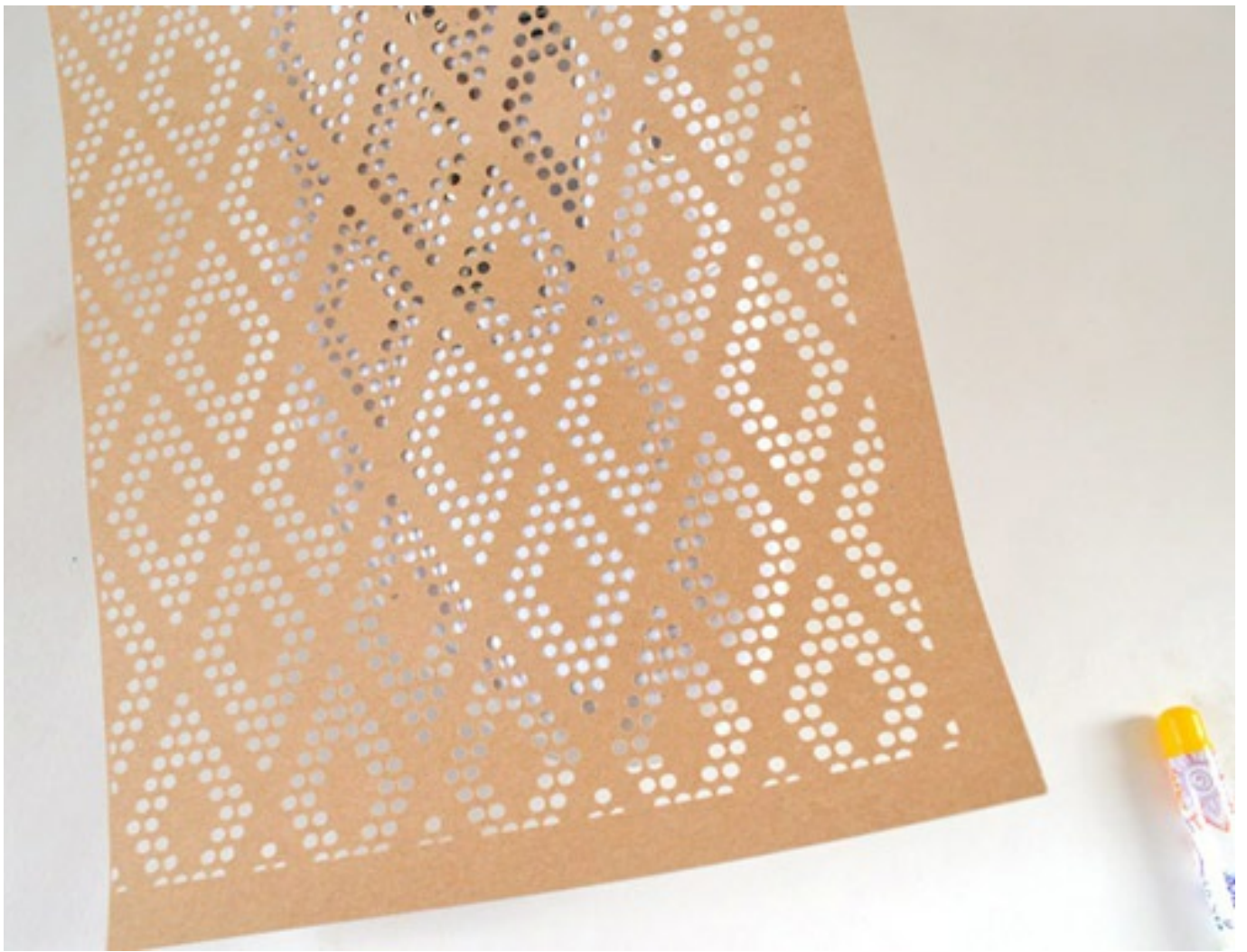


Grab a pair of white sneakers and

your [Tulip Fabric Markers](#) and let's get to it!



I used a stencil to get the perfect shape. Normally I'd freehand it but I was feeling overly like a perfectionist. Use whatever stencil you have on hand or can find at the store. This is one I cut out from a file I purchased at the Silhouette Store.



Spray the backside of the stencil lightly with Aleene's Repositionable Tacky Spray and adhere to the middle of the toe area of your shoe.



Fill in the dots or shapes of your stencil with alternating colors.



When you've done all you can do with the stencil where it is, lightly spray again and tack back down, using some of your previous shapes to help keep your shapes right on track.



When you get to the back of the shoes, stop at the seam. Being able to keep the pattern fluidly around the shoe is highly unlikely so just quit it right there!

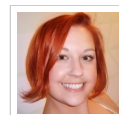


Keep going around and around and on both shoes until you are done!
